### PILGRIMAGE ITINERARY

#### Day 1 – Oct. 8: Depart U.S.A.

Our pilgrimage begins as we depart on our overnight flight to Rome. Meals and refreshments will be served aloft.

#### Day 2 – October 9: Arrive Rome / Assisi

After our morning arrival in Rome we will drive north through the beautiful Umbrian countryside to Assisi, a town which welcomes us in the spirit of St. Francis and St. Clare into its peaceful interior. We will visit St. Mary of the Angels Basilica, site of the Porziuncola, the tiny church in the woods where St. Francis began his ministry and where St. Clare began her religious life. Celebrate Mass and then enjoy some free time in Assisi before dinner.

#### Day 3 – October 10: Assisi


This morning we begin with a tour of Assisi including visits to the Convent of San Damiano where the miracle of the Eucharist of 1211 took place, the Basilica of St. Francis where Mass will be celebrated, and the Basilica of St. Clare. After lunch, visit a local Tuscan winery and enjoy a tasting. In the afternoon, for those with the stamina, take a walk up Monte Subasio to L'Eremo delle Carceri (the Carceri Hermitage), the Saint's favorite retreat. There are many caves here that St. Francis and his followers retreated to for seclusion and prayer. Enjoy dinner out on your own.

#### Day 4 – October 11: Assisi / Siena / Assisi

This morning we will drive to Siena, home of St. Catherine. Our first stop this morning and a highlight of our visit will be the Basilica of St. Francis where we'll venerate the Eucharistic miracle of Siena. Hosts which have remained incorrupt since 1730. Then we'll celebrate Mass at St. Dominic's, St. Catherine of Siena's parish church where she attended daily Mass and







went into ecstasy. Adjacent to the church is her home, which we'll tour and see the cell where she fasted and prayed. Then we'll stroll the ancient Gothic streets which converge on the Piazza del Campo, one of the most beautiful squares in the world where we can stop for lunch. After some free time to explore the Old Town on your own, return to Assisi for dinner.

#### Day 5 - October 12: Assisi / Orvieto / Rome

Depart Assisi and drive to Orvieto where we'll visit Signorelli Chapel in the Cathedral of Orvieto and venerate the sacred Eucharistic miracle. See the steps of the Papal summer residence where Pope Urban IV held up the blood-stained corporal and announced his intention to institute the Feast of Corpus Christi. After Mass, we continue our drive to Rome where the balance of the day will be free.

#### Day 6 – October 13: Rome

This morning we'll head to the Mamertine Prison where St. Paul was kept in chains, view the Forum (outside visit) and Coliseum (outside visit) and stop at the minor Basilica of San Martino ai Monti, which our diocesan cathedral was modeled after. We will celebrate Mass and then proceed to St. Peter in Chains to view Michelangelo's magnificent Moses followed by a visit to St. Mary Major. Dinners for the next three nights will be on your own as you explore the culture of Rome!

#### • Day 7 - October 14: Rome

We'll begin our day in Rome with Mass in St. Peter's Basilica, followed by a tour including the Pieta and Adoration Chapel which our Holy Father opened in 1981. Afterwards we will visit the Sistine Chapel and the Vatican Museum, focusing especially on Eucharistic art and artifacts. In the afternoon, we'll visit the Basilica of St. John Lateran and the Holy Stairs.

#### Day 8 – October 15: Rome

This morning we will visit and celebrate Mass at St. Paul Outside the Walls which was originally built by Constantine in the fourth century over the site of St. Paul's tomb. After our Holy Hour, we will visit the Church of St. Cecilia and then visit the Basilica of Santa Maria in Trastevere, a minor basilica in the Trastevere district of Rome, and one of the oldest churches of Rome. After lunch, visit the Trevi Fountain where a coin thrown over your shoulder will guarantee you another visit to Rome; the Pantheon; Piazza Navona with the famous Bernini's fountains; and Santa Maria sopra Minerva, one of the major churches of the Dominican Order.

#### • Day 9 - October 16: Rome / Subiaco /Rome

Today we will take an excursion outside of Rome. Our first stop will be in hilly Subiaco to visit the early 5th century Sacro Speco (Sacred Grotto) of St. Benedict, his first monastery and the cradle of the Benedictine Order. One of the chapels contains what is believed to be the earliest fresco of St Francis of Assisi, painted from life. Then we will descend to the valley below to visit the Abbey of St. Scholastica, built by St. Benedict for his twin sister. Continue on to Tivoli to visit the Renaissance villa of Cardinal Ippolito d'Este, the son of Lucrezia Borgia, inaugurated in 1572. The villa is rich in fountains and offers a splendid natural landscape that made her famous throughout the world. We'll stroll around the village before driving back to Rome for dinner.

#### Day 10 – October 17: Rome

Today we will experience a highlight of our pilgrimage, attendance at the Papal Audience at St. Peter's (subject to the Holy Father's schedule). Join thousands of pilgrims from throughout the world to listen to the Holy Father and receive His Blessing. After lunch, we will visit the Catacombs of San Callistus where we will celebrate Mass. The remainder of the day will be free for personal activities. This evening enjoy a farewell dinner at a local restaurant.

#### Day 11 - October 18: Rome / U.S.A.

Following breakfast, we will transfer to the airport to catch our return flight home.

Reservations and Payment: Tekton Ministries requires a deposit of \$300.00 per person at the time of booking. This deposit forms a part of your final payment which is due 75 days prior to departure. Reservations made within 74 days of departure must be accompanied by payment in full. Payments made by credit card will incur a convenience fee. Any reservations received within 45 days of departure will incur a late booking fee of \$100.00 per person. This pilgrimage is based upon a minimum of 21 total pilgrims. Surcharges may be assessed for a smaller group size.

**Cancellations:** All cancellations must be in writing. The following per person cancellation charges will apply in addition to any airline penalties and charges incurred by our suppliers: If canceled 91 days or more prior to departure, a \$75.00 administrative fee will be charged. If canceled 90 - 31 days prior to departure, \$175.00 will be charged. If canceled 30 - 15 days prior to departure, \$450.00 will be charged. If canceled 14 - 7 days prior to departure \$700.00 will be charged. No refunds will be made within 6 days of departure. In addition, once the airline tickets have been issued, 100% of the airfare is non-refundable unless you have been advised otherwise at the time of your booking.

**Travel Documents:** A passport which is valid for 6 months past the date of your return flight home is required of all U. S. citizens. However, U.S. citizens do not require visas for Italy. If you are not a U.S. citizen, please call to find out if you need a visa. Tekton Ministries is not responsible for individual visas or passports.

**Hotels:** Accommodations are based on double occupancy rooms with private facilities. A limited number of single rooms are available at the supplement quoted and should be requested at the time of booking.

**Air Transportation:** Air travel is in economy class on Delta Airlines. Fares are based upon levels in effect at the time of printing and fares and flight schedules are subject to change without notice. Note that any ticketing changes made within 90 days of your departure date will incur airline penalties.

**Baggage:** Each passenger is allowed one checked bag and one carry-on. Tekton Ministries is not responsible for lost, damaged or stolen baggage.

**Travel Insurance:** We strongly recommend that you purchase comprehensive travel insurance for your trip. Registration information will be provided upon receipt of your deposit.

**Not Included:** Airline taxes/fuel surcharges (currently \$428.90 per person, but subject to change until the time of ticketing), gratuities to guide, driver, and hotel staff, passport/visa fees, personal travel insurance, laundry, beverages and items not on the regular menu of included meals, excess baggage charges, optional sightseeing and expenses of a personal nature.

**Refunds:** Subject to the foregoing Cancellation Terms, upon cancellation of travel related services, all sums paid to Tekton Ministries/George's International Tours for such services will be promptly returned to the passenger, provided the passenger has not caused such cancellation and is not in violation of any of the terms and conditions previously, clearly and conspicuously disclosed and agreed to by the passenger. This refund provision does not apply where Tekton Ministries/George's International Tours has remitted the payment to another registered seller of travel or a carrier and they default

in providing the agreed-upon transportation or service without providing a refund. In such a situation, Tekton Ministries/George's International Tours agrees to provide passenger with a written statement accompanied by a copy of the bank records establishing the disbursement of the payment, and if disbursed to a seller of travel, proof of their current registration.

**Trust Account Disclosure:** California law requires certain sellers of travel to have a trust account or bond. George's International Tours has such a trust account

Travel Consumer Restitution Corporation ("TCRC"): George's International Tours is a participant in the Travel Consumer Restitution Corporation ("TCRC"). You, the passenger, may request reimbursement from TCRC if George's International Tours was registered and participating in the TCRC at the time of sale and the passenger is located in California at the time of payment. Please be advised that passengers purchasing from outside of California are not covered by the TCRC. Eligible passengers may file a claim with TCRC if the passenger is owed a refund of more than \$50 for transportation or travel services which George's International Tours failed to forward to a proper provider or if such money was not refunded to you when required. The maximum amount, which may be paid by the TCRC to any one passenger is the total amount paid on behalf of the passenger to George's International Tours, not to exceed \$15,000. A claim must be submitted to the TCRC within six months after the scheduled completion date of the travel. A claim must include sufficient information and documentation to prove your claim and a \$35 processing fee. You must agree to waive your right to other civil remedies against a registered participating Seller of Travel for matters arising out of a sale for which you file a claim with the TCRC, if you were located in California at the time of the sale.
