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Reservations and Payment: Tekton Ministries requires a non-refundable deposit of \$300.00 per person at the time of booking. This deposit forms part of your final payment which is due 90 days prior to departure - after receiving the final invoice. All pilgrimage registrations must be made online through our website. Reservations made within 89 days of departure (or after the final invoices are sent) must be accompanied by payment in full. Any credit card payments other than the deposit will incur a convenience fee. Any reservations received within 45 days of departure will incur a late booking fee of \$100.00 per person. Late payments may be subject to a late fee and/or possible removal from the pilgrimage. Pilgrimage prices are based upon a minimum number of TBD total pilgrims. Surcharges may be assessed for smaller group sizes.

Cancellations: All cancellations must be received in writing (email or letter). The following per person cancellation charges will apply in addition to any airline penalties and charges incurred by our suppliers: If canceled 91 days or more prior to departure, \$300 will be charged. If canceled 90 - 61 days prior to departure, \$1000.00 will be charged. If canceled 60 - 31 days prior to departure, \$2000.00 will be charged. No refunds will be made within 30 days of departure. In addition, once the airline tickets have been issued, 100% of the airfare is non-refundable unless you have been advised otherwise at the time of your booking.

Travel Documents: A passport which is valid for 6 months past the date of your return flight home is required of all U.S. citizens. U.S. citizens may also be required to apply for ETIAS (start date TBD) to enter Europe. However, U.S. citizens do not require visas. If you are not a U.S. citizen, please check to find out if you need a visa. Tekton Ministries is not responsible for individual visas or passports.

Hotels: Accommodations are based on double occupancy rooms with private facilities. A limited number of single rooms are available at the supplement quoted and should be requested at the time of booking.

Air Transportation: Air travel is in economy class on TBD. Fares are based upon levels in effect at the time of printing and fares and flight schedules are subject to change without notice. Note that any ticketing changes or cancellations made within 120 days of your departure date will incur airline penalties.

Baggage: Each passenger is allowed one checked bag and one carry-on. Tekton Ministries is not responsible for lost, damaged or stolen baggage.

Travel Insurance: All travelers are required to have comprehensive travel insurance for this trip. Registration information will be provided upon receipt of your deposit.

Not Included in base price: Airline taxes/fuel surcharges (currently estimated at \$700 per person, but subject to change until the time of ticketing), gratuities to guide, driver, and hotel staff, passport/visa fees, CSA travel insurance (required), laundry, beverages and items not on the regular menu of included meals, excess baggage charges, optional sightseeing and expenses of a personal nature.

Refunds: Subject to the foregoing Cancellation Terms, upon cancellation of travel related services, all sums paid to Tekton Ministries/George's International Tours for such services will be promptly returned to the passenger, provided the passenger has not caused such cancellation and is not in violation of any of the terms and conditions previously, clearly and conspicuously disclosed and agreed to by the passenger. This refund provision does not apply where Tekton Ministries/George's International Tours has remitted the

payment to another registered seller of travel or a carrier and they default in providing the agreed-upon transportation or service without providing a refund. In such a situation, Tekton Ministries/George's International Tours agrees to provide passenger with a written statement accompanied by a copy of the bank records establishing the disbursement of the payment, and if disbursed to a seller of travel, proof of their current registration.

Trust Account Disclosure: California law requires certain sellers of travel to have a trust account or bond. George's International Tours has such a trust account.

Travel Consumer Restitution Corporation ("TCRC"): George's International Tours is a participant in the Travel Consumer Restitution Corporation ("TCRC"). You, the passenger, may request reimbursement from TCRC if George's International Tours was registered and participating in the TCRC at the time of sale and the passenger is located in California at the time of payment. Please be advised that passengers purchasing from outside of California are not covered by the TCRC. Eligible passengers may file a claim with TCRC if the passenger is owed a refund of more than \$50 for transportation or travel services which George's International Tours failed to forward to a proper provider or if such money was not refunded to you when required. The maximum amount, which may be paid by the TCRC to any one passenger is the total amount paid on behalf of the passenger to George's International Tours, not to exceed \$15,000. A claim must be submitted to the TCRC within six months after the scheduled completion date of the travel. A claim must include sufficient information and documentation to prove your claim and a \$35 processing fee. You must agree to waive your right to other civil remedies against a registered participating Seller of Travel for matters arising out of a sale for which you file a claim with the TCRC, if you were located in California at the time of the sale. 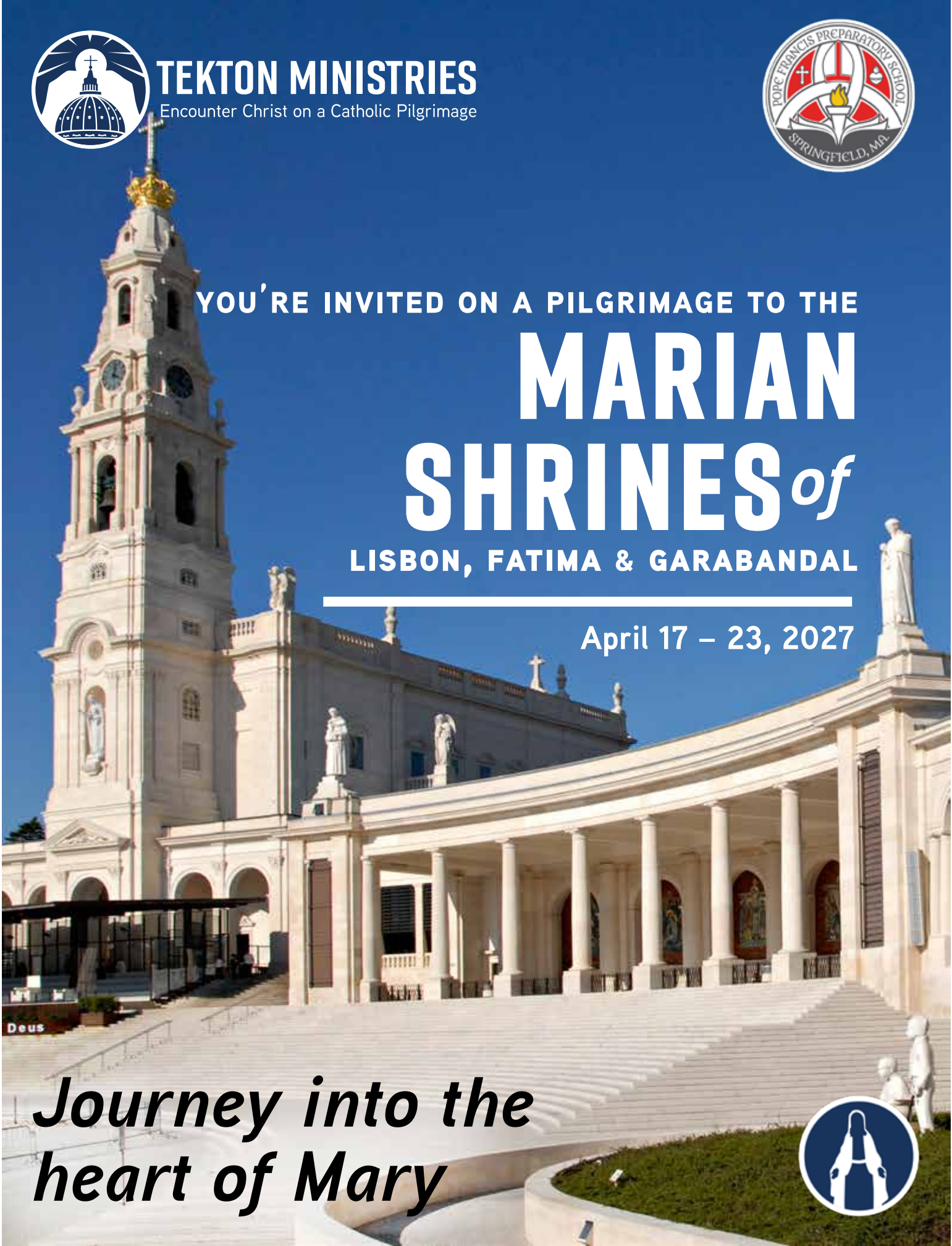

By visiting holy sites and shrines where Our Lady has appeared through the centuries, we hope your faith and relationship with the Blessed Mother will be reinvigorated and renewed by this pilgrimage. Although we visit numerous sites and shrines, daily Mass and time for prayerful reflection are important parts of each day's experience.

We use only experienced Christian or Catholic guides, so you receive truthful explanations of scripture and the places we encounter. When the disciple Philip asked the Eunuch (who was reading Isaiah) if he understood what he was reading, the man responded, "How can I, unless someone guides me?" (Acts 8:35) Just as Philip guided the Eunuch with "the good news of Jesus," your Tekton pilgrimage will guide you into a deeper understanding of the Scriptures. Our prayers, service, and love of our Lord go with you.

- **Day 1- Saturday, April 17**
Depart Boston
Our pilgrimage begins today as we depart on our overnight flight to Lisbon. Meals and drinks served aloft.
- **Day 2 – Sunday, April 18**
Arrive Lisbon / Fatima
Upon arrival in Lisbon, we will be met by our pilgrimage guide, who will be with us throughout our stay. After boarding our motorcoach we will drive to the Church of St. Stephen in Santarem to see one of the greatest Eucharistic Miracles, "The Bleeding Host." In the 13th century, a woman stole the host to take to a fortune teller, but as she was taking it out of church the host began to bleed profusely. Afraid, she put it in a trunk at her home only to be awakened in the middle of the night to a bright light coming from the trunk. She took the host back to the priest; he put it in a wax pyx. Another miracle

happened the next morning when the priest found that the wax had turned into its own crystal pyx where it can be venerated to this day. Then on to Fatima, where our Blessed Mother appeared to three shepherd children. It is where, in 1917, thousands witnessed what became known as the "Miracle of the Sun." The message of Fatima has inspired generations of Catholics to pray the rosary daily for peace and reparation. Visit the Chapel of Apparitions before praying at the graves of Sts. Francisco and Jacinta, and Venerable Lucia. This evening, we participate in the Stations of the Cross along the Via Sacra or the candlelight rosary procession in the heart of the shrine. (D) Overnight Fatima



- **Day 3 – Monday, April 19**
Fatima
This morning, we enjoy a guided tour of the Museum of the Shrine of Fatima, full of history and relics of the apparitions and pilgrims who have visited throughout the past century. View the crown of Our Lady of Fatima, with the bullet used in the assassination attempt on St. Pope John Paul II as part of its unique design. Afterwards, explore the tiny village of Aljustrel, where the three children lived. Continue to Valinhos, where Our Lady appeared to the children after they were unjustly imprisoned. It is here she encouraged them and



told them they must still come every 13th of the month to see her. This evening offers another opportunity to participate in the Stations of the Cross along the Via Sacra or the candlelight rosary procession in the heart of the shrine. (B, D) Overnight Fatima

- **Day 4 – Tuesday, April 20**
Fatima
This morning we will depart Fatima and drive to Lisbon. Upon arrival we will visit the Monastery of Jeronimos, a UNESCO World Heritage Siter. Also known as the Royal Monastery of Saint Mary of Belem, the 16th-century church was built in the Manueline style (named for King Manuel I – ruler during the initial development of the monastery). We will also view the Belem Tower and the Monument to Discoveries before proceeding to the airport to catch our late afternoon flight to Bilbao. Upon arrival in Bilbao we will proceed to our hotel for dinner and overnight. (B, D) Overnight Bilbao



- **Day 5 – Wednesday, April 21**
Bilbao / Garabandal
Today we depart Bilbao and drive to visit the Monastery of Santo Toribio which was dated to the 6th century. According to tradition, the monastery holds the largest piece of the True Cross discovered in Jerusalem by Saint Helena of Constantinople. Brought from the Church of the Holy Sepulchre by Saint Turibius of Astorga, the left arm of the True Cross is kept in a gilded silver reliquary. Afterwards we make our way to Garabandal, Spain. Garabandal is the location of alleged apparitions of the Blessed Virgin Mary and St. Michael the Archangel that occurred in the 1960s. Upon arrival, check into our hotel for dinner and overnight. (B, D) Overnight Garabandal



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- **Day 6 – Thursday, April 22**
Garabandal
After breakfast, visit "The Pines," where many of the apparitions are said to have taken place. Walk the village and spend time reflecting on the messages of conversion, penance, and the importance of the Eucharist in our lives. The balance of the day is free. Later, head back to our hotel for dinner and overnight. (B, D) Overnight Garabandal
- **Day 7 – Friday, April 23**
Garabandal / Bilbao / Boston
Today marks the end of a marvelous experience as we transfer to the airport in Bilbao for the return trip home, filled with memories and graces of this pilgrimage that will last a lifetime. (B)
